My goal this week is to have students "hand in" one assignment that they were given this week. I think I have found a way to use FreshGrade to have students hand in their work so that I can see what they have been doing. This week, I will be asking for them to hand in their **Novel Study work** (it is on Friday's jobs on the schedule that I sent out yesterday). I will give some instructions below on how to do this.

- 1. Go to FreshGrade Student (<u>https://student.freshgrade.com/#login</u>) or get the FreshGrade Student app on a device.
- Students were given their FreshGrade Access Codes a while ago, so they should be able to log in. If they don't know their Access Code, please email me and I will send it to you. (<u>tzellman@sd57.bc.ca</u>)
- Once you have logged in, find the assignment "At Home Novel Study Week 2"
- 4. Click the **Upload** button below the assignment.
- 5. Now you can choose any type of file that you can produce. You could upload a Word document, a pdf, a photo of your written work, or even a video of you telling me your summary, connection, and prediction.
 - Did you know that you can scan a document and make a pdf using an iPhone? It's actually pretty cool!

- 6. Once you have uploaded, wait for the green status bar to be completed before you log out.
- 7. That's it! In theory, I should now have access to the work that you have uploaded.
