

TIME TRAVEL WRITING PROJECT: WEEK ONE

The introduction of your Time Machine

Over the next several weeks you will be writing a Time Travel Adventure Series. This is a chance for you to imagine what it would be like to travel through time and visit places and events in the past. If you need inspiration think of the DeLorean in Back to the Future, Hermione's time turner in Harry Potter, and the treadmill in The Flash to name a few. You will be telling the story from a FIRST person narrative (I/we perspective), so it is YOU that will be travelling through time. You will be given some destinations/times that you must travel to and may take a little research. Every week I will give you new instructions on what tasks need to be finished (similar to our Species Project). Have fun with this and make it interesting as you get to decide what happens on your travels.

Week 1:

This week you will need to write a paragraph introducing your main character as he/she/they invent or stumble upon a time machine. Make sure to include:

- **Where your main character lives (setting)**
- **What your main character has been doing prior to this event**
- **What your main character feels about finding the time machine**
- **What other characters may be involved to start**

You also need to make sure to describe the Time Machine itself. This will be done both through writing (include this in your paragraph), but also through a detailed drawing with labels for the various parts. Don't be afraid to make up parts (ie/ The flux capacitor), and also tell me what the various parts do. You may want to think about:

- **What does the time machine look like (car, phone booth, something new and weird?)**
- **What powers the time machine (garbage, gasoline, nuclear power, kittens, could be anything!)**
- **What special features does the time machine have (eject buttons, turbo, slow motion, things to capture stuff from the past, again can be anything!)**

Please include a detailed illustration!!
