What does your character see while back in the 1990s? Who do they meet along the way? (singers, famous people, prime minister of Canada?) What do you do for fun in the 1999? (what music, films, TV shows were big in 1999) What was a mix-tape, a cassette or a floppy disk? How did people have to connect to the internet (hint: dial-up internet)? What phones did people have and how did they text and communicate?

## Some things to consider:

What buildings in Prince George now were not there in the 1990s? What famous events happened in the 1990s? What Apps, websites etc. not exist (hint: TikTok started in 2016)? What jobs exist now that did not in the 1990s?
